3 4	The group of all licensed independent practitioners and other practitioners privileged
5	through the organized medical staff process that is subject to the medical staff bylaws. This
6	group may include others, such as retired practitioners who no longer practice in the
7	organization but who wish to continue their membership in the group, courtesy staff,
8	scientific staff, etc. (See also <i>medical staff, organized</i> )
9	
10	Medical staff bylaws
11	A document or group of documents adopted by the voting members of the organized
12	medical staff and approved by the governing body that defines the rights, responsibilities,
13	and accountabilities of the medical staff and various officers, persons, and groups within the
14	structure of the organized medical staff; the self-governance functions of the organized
15	medical staff; and the working relationship with and accountability to the governing body of
16	the organized medical staff.
17 18	Medical staff, voting members of the organized
19	Those practitioners within the organized medical staff who have the right to vote on
20	adopting and amending medical staff bylaws, rules and regulations, and policies. (See also
21	medical staff, organized)
22	
23	Rules and regulations and policies of the medical staff
24	As used in these standards, documents other than medical staff bylaws. When adopted by
25	the organized medical staff and approved by the governing body, pursuant to the provisions
26	of Standard MS.01.01.01, these documents have the force and effect of medical staff bylaws.
27	
28	Medical staff, organized
29	A self-governing entity accountable to the governing body that operates under a set of
30	bylaws, rules and regulations, and policies developed and adopted by the voting members of
31	the organized medical staff and approved by the governing body. The organized medical
32 33	staff is comprised of doctors of medicine and osteopathy, and, in accordance with the medical staff bylaws, may include other practitioners.
